Joplin Meet Revenue: \$23,615.00 in registration, gate \$6,295.00, T-shirts \$2375.00 Vendor #1 \$328.14, Bib Repl. \$70.00 Bid Fee \$3,000, Programs \$420.00 Credits \$174.90 Total Revenue \$36,278.04, Expenses \$11,904.31, Exp-awards/Sanctions \$2,538.38, Administrative start up \$150.00, Per Diem \$2500.00 Total profit \$19,185.35.

SIU-E Meet Revenue: Registration \$21,275.00, Gate \$9,788.00, T-shirts \$1,575.00, Vendor #1 \$315.00, Bib repl. \$70.00, Bid Fee .00, Programs .00 credits \$407.26, Total Revenue \$33,430.26. Expenses \$22,093.86, Exp-Awards/Sanctions \$2,538.38, Administrative start up 4150.00, Per Diem \$2500.00. Total profit \$6,148.02.

Revenue Sharing: More than \$14,000 in revenue from the two meets was shared amongst 44 clubs.

The By-Laws were reviewed and changes were made. Larry Bryant asked for a motion to be made to adopt the changes made to the By-Laws. Motion was made by Bobby Carter and seconded by Wanda McNeil 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion that all the changes made to the By-Laws be accepted (Motion passed).
